HOW TO:

Start a Found Pet Alert

Pet Owner

STEP 1: Always begin your pet reunification process by first searching the microchip number on the AAHA Lookup Tool at petmicrochiplookup.org. This site will tell you if this microchip is in fact registered with the Michelson Found Animals Registry or a different registry.

STEP 2: Once you've verified that this pet is registered with us, head over to found.org. You do not need to have an account or be signed in to start a Found Pet Alert*. Click "Start Found Pet Alert" at the top

STEP 3: Enter the microchip number twice to confirm that you are searching the correct chip, then click "Search Our Database"

STEP 4: If the pet is registered, click "Click Here To Notify The Owner" to initiate a Found Pet Alert

If you logged in prior to starting the alert, then you have successfully initiated the alert.

If you did not log in or are a Good Samaritan, move to the next step.

STEP 5: If you're a Good Samaritan or a Pet Owner, choose the "Contact Pet Owner" option

STEP 6: Enter your contact information so that we can connect the registered owner with you, the finder. Click "Click Here to Notify the Owner" to initiate the alert.

The finder's information will only be shared with the Pet Owner in the effort of reunification.
